Day 1 Overnight Flight to Germany

Day 2 D Frankfurt

Welcome to Germany and the city of Frankfurt! Enjoy an orientation **tour of Frankfurt**, see the Cathedral, Goethe's birthplace, and Romeplatz. This evening we will top off arrival with a welcome drink and dinner.

Day 3 B Heidelberg

Today we enter the 'Student Prince' city of Heidelberg with its dominant castle for a **walking tour** through the castle courtyards.

Day 4 B Augsburg

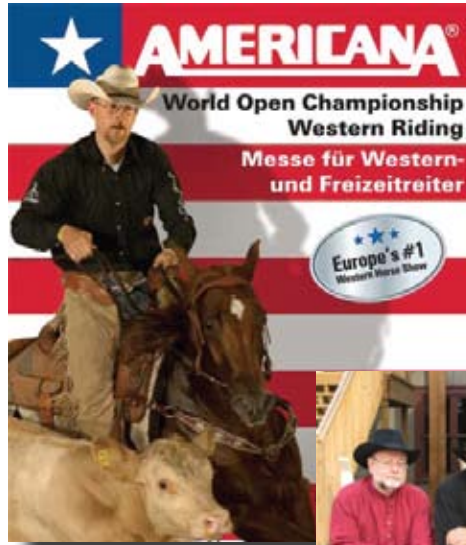
AMERICANA is a world-renown event that attracts top Western riders from all over the world that compete in different disciplines. It is the absolute highlight for every fan of this fascinating sport and the culture of the American West. We'll spend time browsing the 240+ vendors, soaking up the "American old-west" in Europe, and watching the Wranglers perform at the famous **Red Grizzly Saloon** at the fairgrounds.

Day 5 B Munich

After breakfast we drive to **Dachau** village where we visit the sinister concentration camp for sobering reminders of the horrors of World War II. We will next enjoy an **orientation tour** of the lively Bavarian capital, Munich. Highlights include **City Hall**, **Marienplatz** with its famous Glockenspiel Carillon, the **Old and New Town Hall** and the **Olympic Complex**.

Day 6 B, D Munich

An excursion to the **Neuschwanstein Castle**—mad King Ludwig's fairytale castle which has been visited by more than 50 million people since 1886. Later, there's time at leisure. You may wish to visit some of the Munich's fine museums or take an optional excursion to the Nymphenburg Palace. Enjoy dinner at one of the fine local restaurants.



Day 7 B Nuremberg

Drive along the **Romantic Road** to the walled town of **Rothenburg**, where a walking tour shows off half-timbered houses, the historic **Town Hall** and a special hidden treasure. Afterward, a short drive to the city of **Nuremberg**, once one of the most beautiful cities in Germany. See the city highlights including the bustling marketplace.

Day 8 B Berlin

Our journey today brings us to **Dresden**—known as 'Florence on the Elbe'. On our arrival an orientation tour shows us highlights of this astonishing Renaissance city. We will see the **Semper Opera House**, **Saxon Wall** and **Zwinger Palace**. Continue to Berlin for an overnight.



Day 9 B, D Berlin

Both East and West are featured on a **tour** including the **Brandenburg Gate**, Unter der Linden boulevard, the **German State Opera House**, and the **Reichstag Building**. The Wranglers will entertain everyone at the **Berlin Wall** before spending the rest of the day exploring the city and surrounding area on your own.

Day 10 B Cologne

Ride the **Eurocity Train** to Cologne and visit the awesome **Gothic Cathedral**. Its twin 515-foot towers, five naves, splendid stained glass window and the shrine of the Three Holy Kings are eloquent testimony to the quality of medieval engineering and craftsmanship.

Day 11 B Frankfurt

After the **city tour of Cologne**, **cruise the Rhine River** along the most scenic section, with castle-crested hills, terraced vineyards and pretty wine towns. This afternoon, enjoy a **farewell concert** with the Wranglers.

Day 12 B Home

We will depart to Frankfurt Airport for our flight home after our incredible Germany experience!
